

## **Preach the Word**

### **2 Timothy 4:1-5 NASB 1995**

*4 I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: <sup>2</sup> preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. <sup>3</sup> For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, <sup>4</sup> and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths. <sup>5</sup> But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.*

**Three Points:                      When                      What                      How**

**When** – “in season and out of season”

### **Acts 9:13-15 NASB 1995**

*<sup>13</sup> But Ananias answered, “Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he did to Your saints at Jerusalem; <sup>14</sup> and here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name.” <sup>15</sup> But the Lord said to him, “Go, for he is a chosen instrument of Mine, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel;*

### **1 Thessalonians 3:2-3 NASB 1995**

*<sup>2</sup> and we sent Timothy, our brother and God’s fellow worker in the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith, <sup>3</sup> so that no one would be disturbed by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we have been destined for this.*

### **Jonah 1:1-3 NASB 1995**

*<sup>1</sup> The word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai saying, <sup>2</sup> “Arise, go to Nineveh the great city and cry against it, for their wickedness has come up before Me.” <sup>3</sup> But Jonah rose up to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. So he went down to Joppa, found a ship which was going to Tarshish, paid the fare and went down into it to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.*

**What** – “reprove, rebuke, exhort”

**Proverbs 28:23 NASB 1995**

<sup>23</sup> *He who rebukes a man will afterward find more favor than he who flatters with the tongue.*

**Luke 17:2-3 NASB 1995**

<sup>2</sup> *It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were thrown into the sea, than that he would cause one of these little ones to stumble. <sup>3</sup>Be on your guard! If your brother sins, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.*

**Acts 2:38-40 NASB 1995**

<sup>38</sup> *Peter said to them, “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <sup>39</sup>For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself.” <sup>40</sup>And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, “Be saved from this perverse generation!”*

**Titus 2:11-15 NASB 1995**

<sup>11</sup> *For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, <sup>12</sup>instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, <sup>13</sup>looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, <sup>14</sup>who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. <sup>15</sup>These things speak and exhort and reprove with all authority. Let no one disregard you.*

**How** – “great patience and instruction”

**Ephesians 4:1-3 NASB 1995**

<sup>1</sup> *Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, <sup>2</sup>with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, <sup>3</sup>being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.*

**Galatians 5:22-23 NASB 1995**

<sup>22</sup> *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.*

## **1 Timothy 1:3-5 NASB 1995**

<sup>3</sup>As I urged you upon my departure for Macedonia, remain on at Ephesus so that you may instruct certain men not to teach strange doctrines, <sup>4</sup>nor to pay attention to myths and endless genealogies, which give rise to mere speculation rather than furthering the administration of God which is by faith. <sup>5</sup>But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

## **2 Thessalonians 3:14-15 NASB 1995**

<sup>14</sup>If anyone does not obey our instruction in this letter, take special note of that person and do not associate with him, so that he will be put to shame. <sup>15</sup>Yet do not regard him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

## **Colossians 4:5-6 NASB 1995**

<sup>5</sup>Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. <sup>6</sup>Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

## **Response to the Plan of Salvation - KJV**

**HEAR the GOSPEL** – **Romans 10:17** So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God

**BELIEVE** – **Hebrews 11:6** But without faith it is impossible to please Him; for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him

**REPENT** – **Luke 13:3** I tell you nay, but except ye repent ye shall all likewise perish

**CONFESS** – **Matthew 10:32-33** Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven

**BE BAPTIZED** – **Acts 22:16** And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord

**FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH** – **Revelation 2:10** Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
